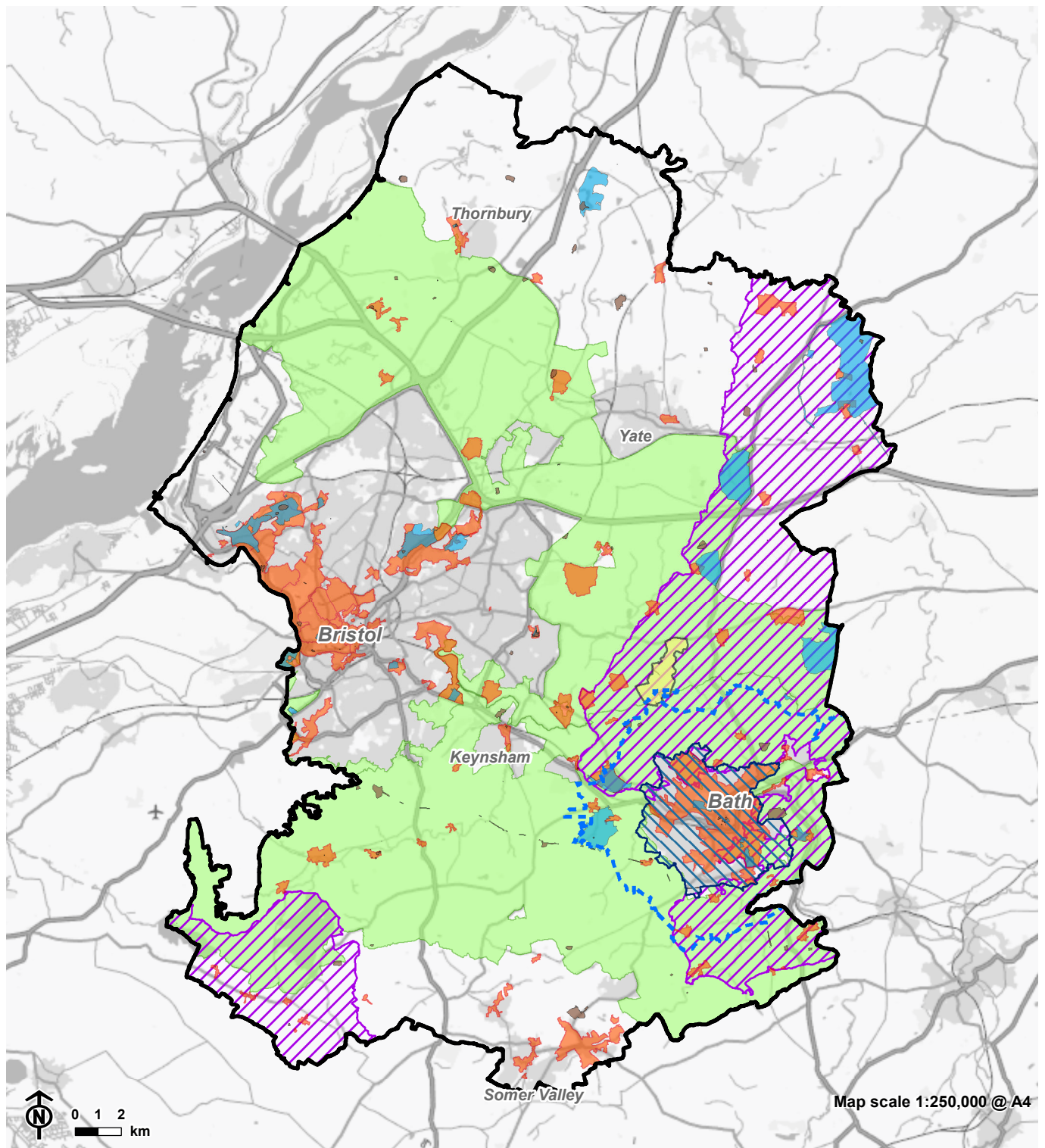


Heritage and landscape areas including the Green Belt

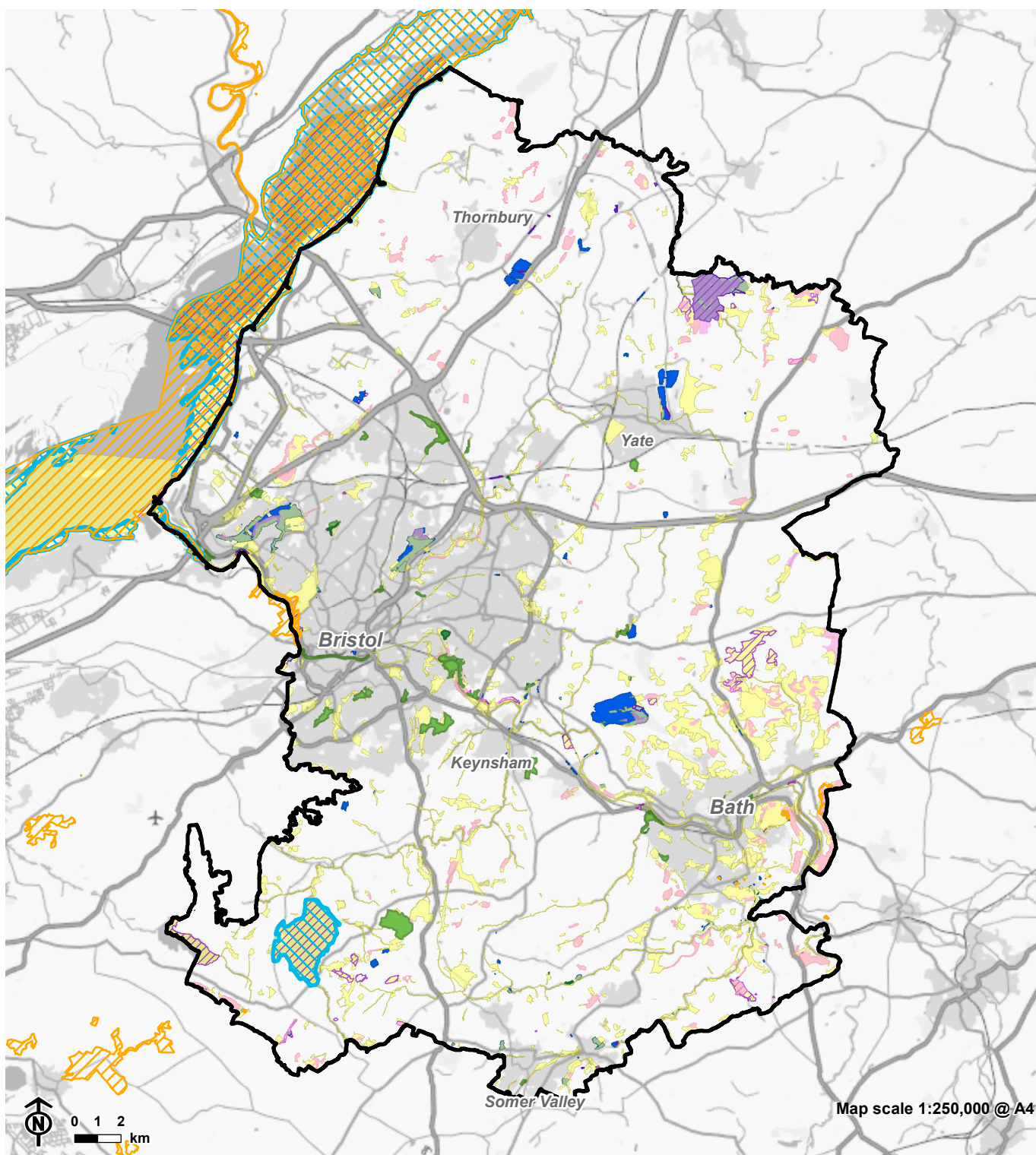

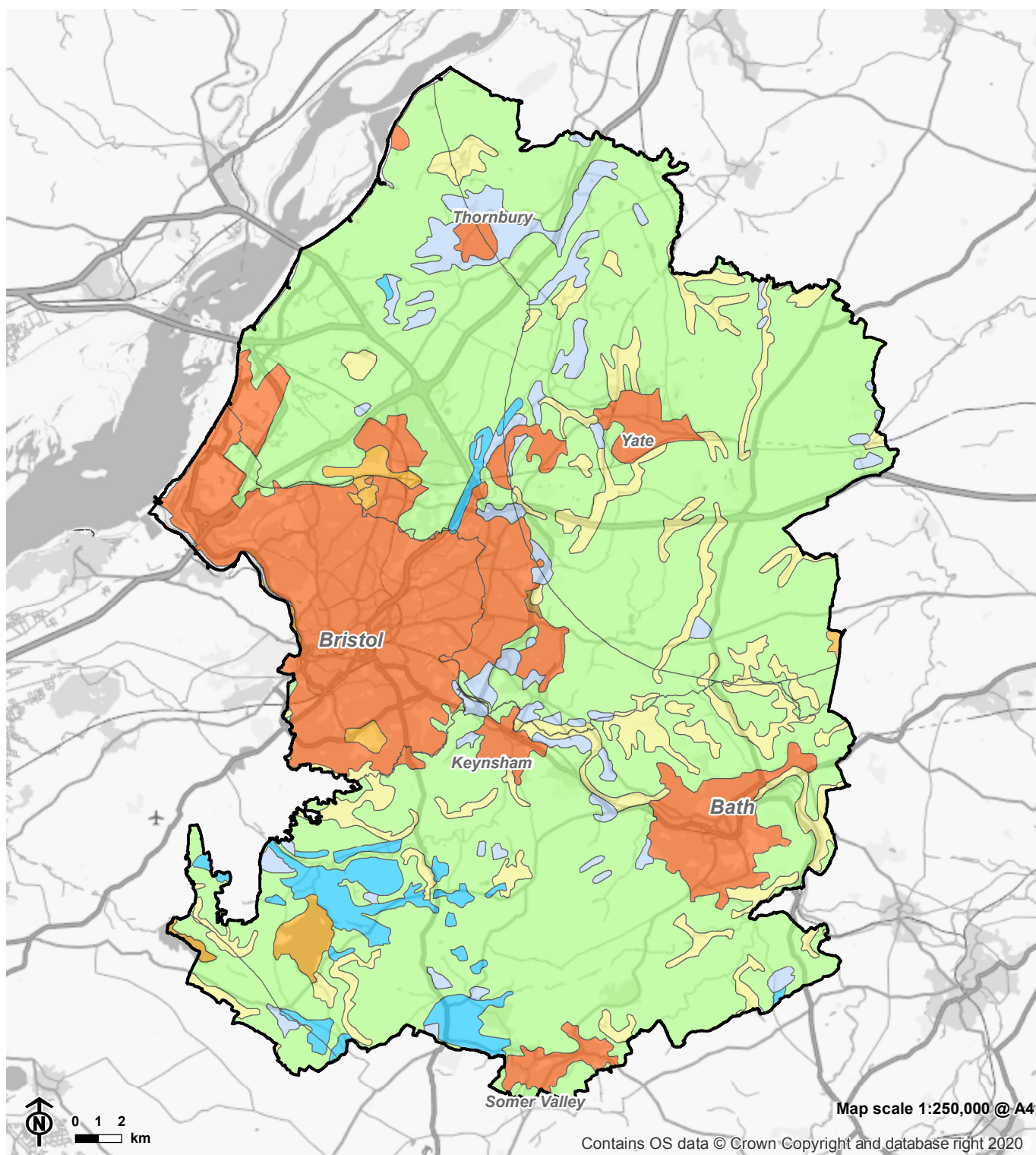


Map indicating the quality of agricultural land in the Spatial Development Strategy area.







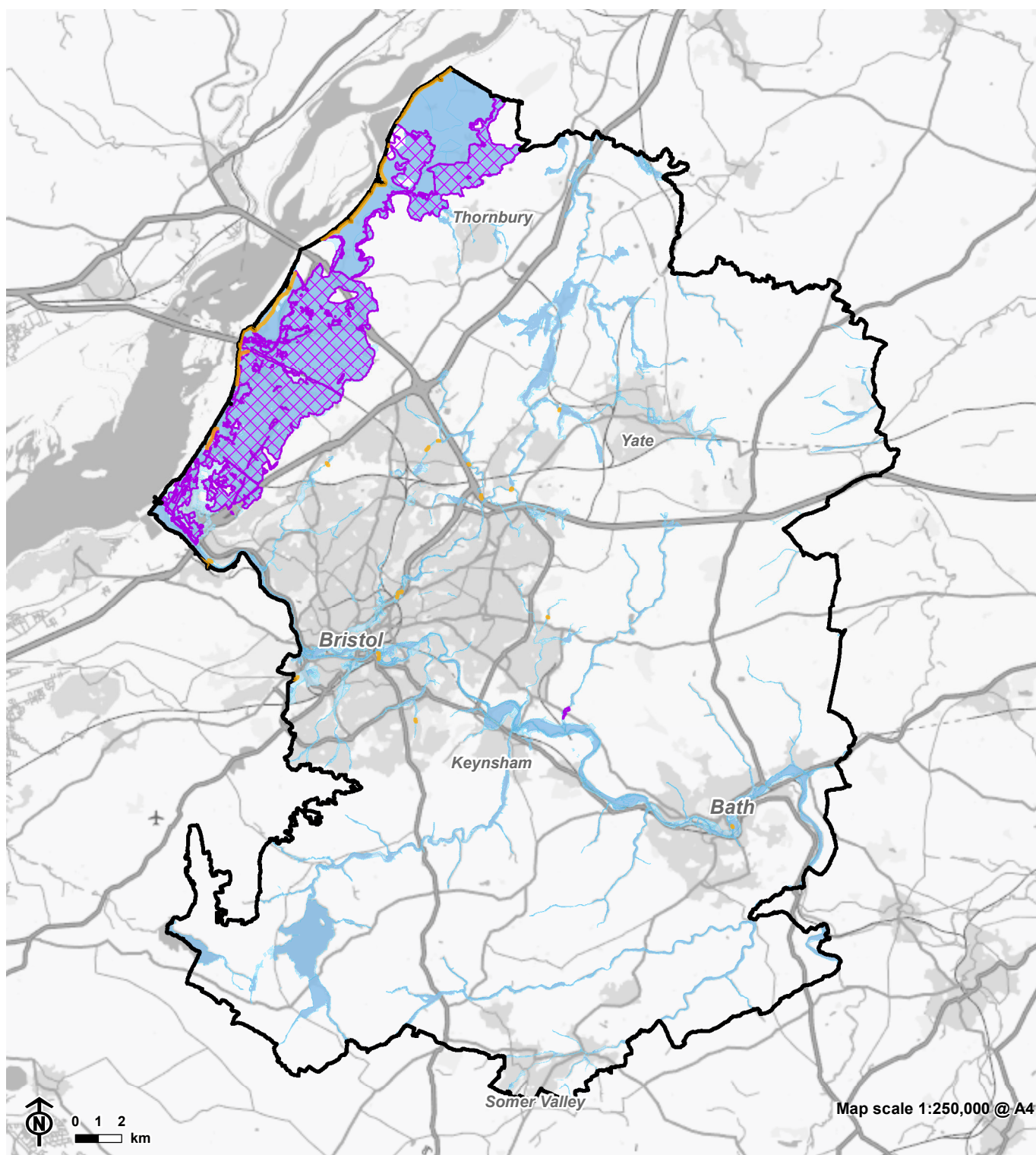

Flood risk areas






This map shows the flood risk areas in the Spatial Development Strategy area.
